OUR STRUCTURE & LEADERSHIP

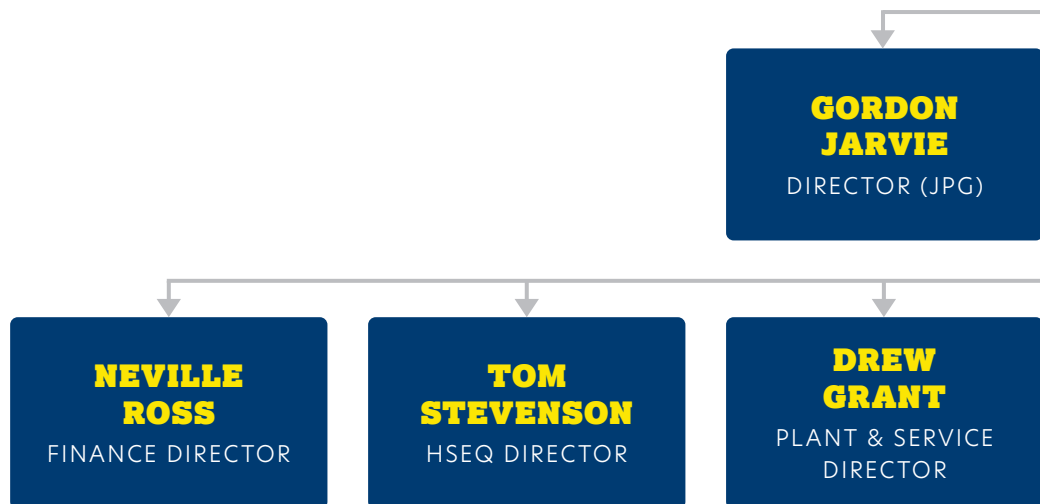
Jarvie Plant is proud to remain a family-owned and family-led business, now in its third generation.

Our engineers check major items of plant on a regular basis whilst they are on site. When a service becomes due, an appointment is arranged to carry out the work at a mutually convenient time. Large items of plant are tagged with service hours so that operators can advise us when a service is due.

We aim to have an engineer on site within two hours of your call and a maximum response time of 4 hours. A 24 hour call out service is available if required.

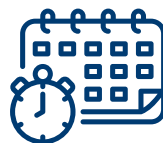

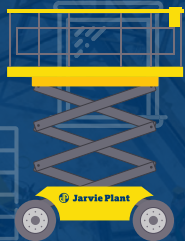

Jarvie Plant Group is a growing and expanding organisation and the successful operation of the business with employee collaboration is paramount to our current and future success, job security and the development of our company.



ISO Certification

The attainment of ISO 9001:2015 (Quality), ISO 14001:2015 (Environment) and OHSAS 18001:2007 (Occupational Health and Safety Management) and the subsequent 3rd party annual audits to maintain these awards; and also the continuous improvement of Jarvie Plant Group - HSEQ management systems, keeps the

management team and HSEQ Manager busy inspecting and auditing the various depots and departments thus ensuring full compliance with all the aspects of safety, health, environment and the various quality issues in our hire business.

CHAS Accreditation

Jarvie Plant Group has also attained the "Contractors Health & Safety Accreditation Scheme" (CHAS) award which is another measurement of our company H&S success.

Our health and safety standards are as expected very high, this being shown in our accident & incident statistics which show a drop of 50% over 5 years.

Constructionline Membership

As a verified member of Constructionline (Silver Member), Jarvie Plant aligns to industry and government standards. This allows buyers to be confident that Jarvie Plant provides a first class service within plant, accommodation and vehicles to match their requirements.

Health and Safety Management System

Jarvie Plant Group has a very comprehensive health and safety management system which has been accepted and is being applied by all employees from Director to shop floor; this being visible in the diminishing accident record and increased health and safety communications by Managers and Supervisors to their respective employees,

Tom Stevenson, leading our commitment to safe, responsible working practices across all operations



discussing the various health and safety updates and issues thus promoting “Talk Safety and Work Safely”.

Every depot/department is also “3rd party” audited quarterly to ensure full compliance with all the above accreditations.

We continue to demonstrate our commitment and energy in being a leading class when it comes to HSEQ standards.

Site Specific Risk Assessments

Site specific risk assessment and method statements are checked and updated as required prior to issue; generic risk assessments are also part of a quality annual review, thus ensuring that our clients receive our plant and accommodation units in a “safe and effective” manner.

Health and Safety Training

Health and safety training is another valuable attribute to our safety management system; all our management team have completed an IOSH H&S training course - Directors, Managers, Supervisors, employees attend various training packages related to their work task skill - Construction Skills CPCS & CSCS, IPAF, PASMA, SVQ's and various other product related training courses.

At Jarvie Plant Group we have developed a work at height “boxing ring” to allow work at height on the top of accommodation units being overhauled prior to hire, this work being actioned in a very safe manner.

This is only part of the Health and Safety success of the Jarvie Plant Group as we never stop trying to improve our progress to a safer workplace and further development of safe working conditions and practices.

When you sign the form on page 1 of this rental agreement, you accept the conditions set out in this rental agreement. Please read this agreement carefully. If there is anything you do not understand, ask a member of staff to explain it.

2. RENTAL PERIOD

You will have the vehicle for the period shown in the agreement. If you do not bring back the vehicle on time, you will be breaking the conditions of this agreement. We can charge you for every day or part of the day you have the vehicle after you should have returned it to us. We will charge you a daily or hourly rate (which will be shown at the place you have rented the vehicle from) until we get our vehicle back.

If you break our agreement, we can ask you to bring back the vehicle before the date and time we have agreed with you. To do this we will give you written notice in person or send it to the address you have given on. Once we have given you the notice in person, you will no longer have our permission to have the vehicle. If we send you a notice in the post, one day after we have posted it you will no longer have our permission to have the vehicle. We may then take back our vehicle. If we believe you have given us false information, we may take back the vehicle without giving you any notice.

3. YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

(a) You must inspect the vehicle and any accessories we provide before you take the vehicle. If you are not satisfied with the vehicle or you do not think the condition of the vehicle meets our pre-rental inspection report, you should let us know.

(b) You must look after the vehicle, any accessories and the keys or other locking device for the vehicle. You must always lock the vehicle when you are not using it, and use any security device which is fitted or which we supply. You must always protect the vehicle against weather conditions which could cause damage. You must make sure that you use the correct type of fuel and fluids in the vehicle.

(c) Depending on section 8 of this agreement ('Our motor insurance and damage protection programme'), you are responsible for any damage to the vehicle, including damage caused by hitting low-level objects such as bridges or low-hanging tree branches. You will have to pay our reasonable costs for bringing the vehicle back to the condition stated in the pre-rental inspection report. This could include the cost of any damage inside and outside the vehicle, cleaning costs if the vehicle is very dirty, and replacing any items or accessories.

(d) You must not sell, rent or get rid of the vehicle or any of its parts. You must not give or try to give anyone the legal rights to the vehicle or transfer legal ownership.

(e) You must not let anyone work on the vehicle without our permission. If we do give you permission, we will only give you a refund if you have a receipt for the work we have given you permission for.

(f) You must let us know as soon as you become aware of a fault with the vehicle, or if the vehicle is stolen or involved in an accident.

(g) If we have agreed to drop off the vehicle at an address you give us, you will be responsible for the vehicle from the time we drop it off.

(h) Unless we have agreed to collect the vehicle from you must return the vehicle to the location or rental branch we agreed. You must return it during the opening hours or at a time we tell you. When you return the vehicle, our staff must check its condition. If we have agreed to allow you to return the vehicle outside of our opening hours, you will stay responsible for the vehicle and its condition until our staff have checked it. We may need to clean the vehicle before our staff can check its condition.

(i) You must not carry any object or substance which, because of its condition or smell, may harm the vehicle or delay us renting or selling it.

4. OUR RESPONSIBILITIES

(a) We will identify and tell you about any existing damage to the vehicle before you sign this agreement.

(b) We have maintained the vehicle to at least the manufacturer's recommended standard. The vehicle is roadworthy and suitable for you to use at the start of the rental period.

(c) We are responsible if someone is injured or dies as a result of our action or failure to act. We are also responsible for any loss you suffer as a result of us breaking this agreement, if we could have predicted your loss at the time this agreement started and it is a result of us breaking this agreement. We are not responsible for any loss which is a side effect of the main loss and which we or you could not have predicted, such as loss of profits or loss of opportunity (for example not being able to go to a business meeting).

(b5) for racing, pacemaking, or to test the vehicle's reliability or speed;

(b6) off roads or on roads unsuitable for the vehicle;

(b7) if the driver has been drinking alcohol or taking drugs;

(b8) outside the United Kingdom, unless we have given you written permission and a Vehicle on Hire Certificate;

(b9) if it is loaded beyond the manufacturer's maximum weight recommendations;

(b10) to carry unsecured loads;

(b11) to carry more passengers than the vehicle was manufactured to legally carry; or

(b12) if the driver does not have a valid operator's licence (if it is a goods vehicle or a minibus).

7. CHARGES

We work out our charges using our current price list, which includes VAT. You will be responsible for paying the following charges.

(a) The rental and any other charges we work out according to this agreement.

(b) Any charge for loss or damage resulting from you not keeping to your responsibilities, as set out in section 3 (above).

(c) A refuelling service charge if you did not return the vehicle to us with the agreed amount of fuel. The charge will be based on the rates set out on page 1 of this agreement or those at the location or rental branch you rented the vehicle from (or both).

(d) All charges and legal costs for any congestion charge, road-traffic offence or parking offence, or any other offence involving the rental vehicle, including costs from the vehicle being clamped, seized or towed away. You are responsible for paying the appropriate authority or company for any charges and costs if and when they ask for these payments. You will also be responsible for paying our reasonable administration charges for dealing with these matters.

(e) The reasonable cost of repairing any damage to the vehicle which was not noted at the start of the agreement, whether you were at fault or not (depending on section)

4. You will also be responsible for paying the reasonable cost of replacing the vehicle if it is stolen or written off, depending on any insurance you have (as set out in section 8), if and when we demand this payment.

(f) A loss-of-income charge, when we demand it, if we cannot rent out the vehicle because it needs to be repaired, if it is a write-off (it cannot be repaired), or if it has been stolen and we are waiting to receive a full payment of the vehicle's value.

(g) We will only charge you for loss of income if we cannot get back our losses under the damage protection programme, as explained in section 8. We will charge you at the published daily or hourly rate, and we will never charge you for more than 30 days. We will always do everything we can to make sure we repair the vehicle or get back our costs as soon as possible.

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(h) Any recovery charges arising from the Driver and Vehicle Standards Agency (DVSA), HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC), the police, or any other public organisation (or their agent) who has seized the vehicle. You will also have to pay us a loss-of-income charge while we cannot rent out the vehicle.

(i) Any published rates for delivering and collecting the vehicle, a charge for an extra driver or returning the vehicle late, and charges for accessories such as child car seats, satellite navigation systems and other similar items.

(j) Interest, which we will add every day to any amount you do not pay us on time, at the rate of 4% a year above the base lending rate as published by Barclays Bank. We will publish this rate from time to time.

(k) We will work out all charges in line with this agreement, and they will include VAT (if this applies). You are responsible for all charges, even if you have asked someone else to be responsible for them.

8. OUR MOTOR INSURANCE AND DAMAGE PROTECTION PROGRAMME

You can get full details of our damage protection programme from the office at which you rented the vehicle. If we arrange separate motor insurance, we will give you information on the motor insurance cover and any restrictions which may apply. Otherwise, the conditions of our motor insurance and damage protection programme will apply. By putting your initials in the appropriate box on of the rental agreement, you are accepting the conditions of our motor insurance and damage protection programme.

(a) We have a legal responsibility to have third-party motor insurance. This provides cover for claims if you injure or kill anybody, or damage their property. Cover for damage to property is limited to £1 million.

(b) We will provide cover for loss or damage to the vehicle if you have put your initials in the box marked 'Collision and loss damage waiver'. Even if you accept this, you still have to pay an amount up to the 'responsibility amount' every time you damage the vehicle. The responsibility amount you have to pay in each case is shown on page 1 [of the rental agreement].

(c) We will provide cover for theft and damage to the vehicle caused during a theft or attempted theft if you have put your initials in the box marked 'Theft waiver' of the rental agreement. Even if you accept this, you still have to pay an amount up to the 'responsibility amount' if the vehicle is stolen.

(d) We will, if available, provide personal accident insurance, personal belongings insurance and goods-in-transit insurance if you have put your initials in the appropriate boxes on the rental agreement. You are

responsible for deciding whether these products are suitable for your needs. We are not responsible if the product does not meet your needs.

9. YOUR OWN INSURANCE

If we fill in the appropriate box on of the rental agreement, you may arrange your own motor insurance to cover your legal responsibility for any loss, or if the vehicle is stolen or damaged, for the full period you are renting the vehicle for. You must prove that this motor insurance is valid and sign the confirmation on of the rental agreement.

We have the right to agree:

- The amount of cover you arrange;
- The type of policy you choose; and
- The insurer you choose.

We must be satisfied with the insurance cover and policy conditions, and you must not change them. We may ask your insurers to record our name as owner of the vehicle. If the vehicle is damaged or stolen we will negotiate any settlement for loss or damage with your insurers, and we will receive any money they pay out. This includes allowing us to take legal action in your name and defending any proceedings taken against you. You are responsible for paying the full claim and paying all costs if the policy you have arranged fails and the vehicle is damaged, lost or stolen, or someone else makes a claim.

10. WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE AN ACCIDENT OR THE VEHICLE IS STOLEN

If you are involved in an accident, you must not admit that you are responsible. You should describe the situation as fully as possible when you are asked to do so by the police and us. You should get the names and addresses of everyone involved, including witnesses. You should also:

(a) make sure the vehicle is secure;

(b) tell the police straight away if anyone is injured or if on of the rental agreement. If the vehicle has been stolen, you must tell us as soon as possible and confirm this in writing as soon as reasonably possible. You or any authorised drivers will also need to:

- Get the names and addresses of any witnesses and give them to us;
- Send us any notices or other documents relating to any legal proceedings arising out of the theft or loss;

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- Help us and our insurers in any legal proceedings, including allowing us to take legal action in your name and defending any legal action taken against you; and
- Give us back all keys and report the theft or loss to the police as soon as reasonably possible.

11 DATA PROTECTION

By entering into this rental agreement you agree that we can process and store your personal information in connection with this agreement. We will use your information to analyse statistics, or market research, credit control and to protect our assets.

You agree that if you break the terms of this agreement we can pass your personal information to credit-reference agencies, debt collectors, the police or any other relevant organisation. We can also give this information to the British Vehicle Rental and Leasing Association (BVRLA), which can share your personal information with its members to prevent crime and protect its assets, as allowed under the Data Protection Act 1998.

12 ENDING THIS AGREEMENT

(a) We will end this agreement if we find out that your belongings have been taken away from you to pay off your debts, or a receiving order has been made against you. We may end this agreement if you do not meet its main conditions.

(b) If you are a company, we will end this agreement if: You go into liquidation; You call a meeting of creditors; We find out that your goods have been taken away from you until you pay off your debts; or you do not meet any of the conditions of this agreement.

(c) If we end this agreement it will not affect our right to receive any amount you owe us under the conditions of this agreement. We can also claim reasonable costs from you if you do not meet the main conditions of this agreement. We can repossess the vehicle and charge you a reasonable amount for doing so.

13 THE LAW

We aim to deal with all disagreements fairly and calmly. If we cannot deal with a disagreement, we may take the matter to the BVRLA's conciliation service. This agreement is governed by the laws of the country in which you signed it. Any disagreement may be settled in the courts of that country. This agreement contains all the conditions which we have agreed and replaces any written or verbal agreements we have with you.

HIRING WITH CONFIDENCE

All invoices are payable in advance for the agreed period plus a deposit except where a credit account has been approved when invoices are then payable at the end of the month following date of invoice or when the credit limit is exceeded whichever is first. Charges will automatically be made to credit cards if the hire continues over two weeks or if the continuing hire charge exceeds the deposit. Sales are payable on delivery. Title to all good sold remains with Jarvie Plant Group Limited until paid for in full.

IMPORTANT: AN 'OFF HIRE NO.' OR A RECEIPT MUST BE OBTAINED BY THE HIRER TO CONFIRM ALL OFF HIRE INSTRUCTIONS.

All plant and accommodation hired is transacted under SPOA conditions of hire. Full conditions are available on request and on the reverse of delivery tickets. A summary of these conditions are listed below.

- (a) Hire rates are based on a 5 day, 40 hour week. Excess hours are charged pro-rata.
- (b) Hire charges commence on the day the plant leaves our depot and terminate on the day it is returned. Each of these days is charged as a full day.
- (c) There is a minimum hire charge for Plant:
 - a. One day = 50% of the weekly rate
 - b. Two days = 60% of the weekly rate
 - c. Three days = 80% of the weekly rate
 - d. Four days + = 100% of the weekly rate
 - e. Accommodation 200% of the weekly rate. Thereafter each day is charged at 20% of the weekly rate. Please refer to our current price list for details and rates.
- (d) The hirer is responsible for daily maintenance of the plant including the supply of fuel, oil, grease etc.
- (e) Any faults or breakdown must be notified immediately.
- (f) Consumables will be charged at start of hire and sharpening of steel and fuel used will be charged on completion of the hire.
- (g) The hirer is responsible for loss of or damage to the plant for any reason whatsoever until received by us and a receipt obtained and should arrange suitable insurance to cover this risk.
- (h) All damage to tyres and tubes is the responsibility of the hirer and repairs carried out are at the hirer's expense.

(i) Transport to and from site is extra. All vehicle rentals are transacted under BVRLA conditions of hire. Refer to deliver advice for details.

(a) All use is restricted to mainland UK

(b) Excess mileage will be charged as per our standard list price. Daily rates include 150 miles. Weekly rates include 600 miles.

(c) Congestion charges and road traffic fines not paid by the hirer will be paid by JP Vehicle Rentals Ltd and re-invoiced to the customer at cost plus £20 per offence. Additional expenses incurred in recovering overdue accounts will be payable. This includes court expenses, statutory interest at bank rate + 8%, compensation on all late payments and bank charges for returned cheques. It is agreed sums invoiced become due for payment immediately if terms of payment are not honoured.*

(Ref: Late Payment of Commercial Debts Interest Act 1998 as amended and supplemented by the Commercial Debts Regulation 2002)*

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF HIRE

1. DEFINITIONS

(a) In these Conditions:-

“Delivery” means when the Plant is uplifted by the Hirer from the Owner’s depot or delivered to the Hirer’s site or other delivery location agreed between the Owner and the Hirer.

“Hire Charges” means the various charges detailed in Condition 12.

“Hirer” means the person, firm or company taking the Plant on hire, including their successors, representatives and agents.

“Off Hire Number” means a unique number provided by the Owner confirming that the Hirer is no longer responsible for meeting Hire Charges.

“Owner” means the person, firm or company letting out the Plant on hire and includes their successors and assignees.

“Period of Hire” means from the time of commencement until the time of expiry of the period of hire as defined by Condition 3.

“Plant” means any machine, equipment or part of them which the Owner agrees to hire to the Hirer in accordance with these Conditions.

“SPOA” means the Scottish Plant Owners Association.

“Standing Time” means the time during which the Plant supplied with an operator is standing idle and available for work.

“Working Week” means from start of business on a Monday until close of business on the following Friday.

(b) In these Conditions words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa and any gender includes any other gender and the neuter.

2. GENERAL

(a) These Conditions shall be incorporated into and shall govern each contract (“the Contract”) for the hire of Plant entered into between the Owner and the Hirer to the exclusion of any terms or conditions of the Hirer. No variation of any of these Conditions shall be effective unless in writing and signed by an authorised representative of the Owner. If the Hirer’s order attempts to exclude these Conditions, such exclusion shall be ineffective unless expressly agreed to in writing by an authorised representative of the Owner.

(b) Nothing in these Conditions shall exclude or limit any statutory rights of the Hirer which may not be excluded or limited due to the Hirer acting as a consumer. Any provision which would be void under any consumer protection legislation shall, to that extent, have no force or effect.

3. PERIOD OF HIRE

(a) In these Conditions, unless the context otherwise requires, the time of commencement of the Period of Hire is:-

(i) in a case where the Plant is collected by the Hirer from the Owner’s depot or elsewhere, the time it is so collected;

(ii) in a case where the Plant comes under the control or direction of the Hirer or his agent before arrival at the Hirer’s site, the time it becomes subject to such control or direction; or

(iii) in all other cases, the time the Plant arrives at the Hirer’s site.

(b) In these Conditions, unless the context otherwise requires, the time of expiry of the Period of Hire is:-

(i) in a case where the Plant is returned by the Hirer to the Owner’s depot or to such other destination as may be directed by the Owner, the time of its arrival there; or

(ii) in a case where the Plant comes under the control and direction of the Owner after leaving the Hirer’s site but before arriving at the Owner’s depot or such other destination as may be directed by the Owner, the time it becomes subject to the Owner’s control or direction.

4. OWNERSHIP

(a) The Plant shall remain the property of the Owner at all times.

(b) Subject to these Conditions, risk in, and liability for loss or damage to, Plant supplied by the Owner to the Hirer shall pass to the Hirer at the time of commencement of the Period of Hire.

5. NOTIFICATION OF DEFECTS, SAFE KEEPING OF PLANT

(a) **NOTIFICATION OF DEFECTS.** The Hirer or his representative shall inspect the Plant on Delivery. The Plant shall be deemed to be in good order (save for latent defects and defects not reasonably ascertainable by inspection) and no claim for loss and damage shall be considered by the Owner unless the Hirer gives written notice to the Owner of an alleged defect within 24 hours of delivery.

(b) **SAFE KEEPING OF PLANT.** The Hirer or his representative shall until the time of expiry of the Period of Hire keep himself acquainted with the state, condition and use of the Plant, ensure its safekeeping, and use it in a workmanlike manner only and not for any purpose beyond its capacity nor in any way likely to result in undue deterioration. If the Plant is stolen, the Hirer will report the theft to the police and supply a detailed description of the Plant to assist in its recovery.

(c) **VANDALISM.** Without prejudice to (b) hereof, the Hirer will be responsible to the Owner for destruction of or damage to the Plant caused maliciously or mischievously by any party whilst it is in his care or under his control. Destruction of or damage to Plant will be presumed to have been caused maliciously or mischievously and the onus of rebutting that presumption will be on the Hirer.

(d) On expiry of the hire the Hirer shall be responsible for returning the Plant to the Owner or allowing the Owner access to uplift it, whichever is agreed between the Owner and the Hirer, in the same condition as on Delivery (fair wear and tear excepted).

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF HIRE

6. BREAKDOWN

(a) Except as otherwise provided in Condition 5(a), any breakdown or unsatisfactory working of Plant must be notified to the Owner within 24 hours of its discovery by the Hirer or his representative. Breakdown time claims will only be considered from the time of notification. In default of such notification the Owner shall be deemed to have properly performed its obligations under the Contract. In the event of a breakdown or unsatisfactory working of Plant, not readily repairable, the Owner shall be entitled to supply substitution Plant of a similar type and condition. If the Owner is not in a position to do so, the Contract shall be terminated as from the date of the breakdown.

(b) The breakdown or stoppage of any one item of Plant shall not entitle the Hirer to claim any compensation or allowance for the loss of working time by any other item of Plant working in conjunction with it.

(c) Each unit of Plant specified in the Contract is hired as a separate item unless expressly hired together with other unit(s) of Plant as a single composite item.

7. ALLOWANCES

(a) Provided notification has been made to the Owner in accordance with these Conditions, the Hirer will not be charged for any stoppages for normal working repairs or due to breakdown of Plant caused by an inherent fault or fair wear and tear. The Hirer's only remedy for such stoppages shall be an allowance up to the amount of Hire Charges otherwise due.

(b) No allowance will be made for stoppages resulting from any other cause for which the Owner is not responsible (including bad weather and ground conditions).

8. SERVICING AND INSPECTION

(a) The Hirer shall allow the Owner, his representatives or insurers access to the Plant at all reasonable times for the purposes of inspecting, testing, adjusting, repairing or replacing it.

9. HIRER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

(a) Except as otherwise provided in Conditions 5 & 6, the Hirer shall reimburse the Owner for all loss or damage to the Plant (fair wear and tear excepted) during the Period of Hire whether or not caused by fault on the part of the Hirer and shall indemnify the Owner in respect of all claims by third parties for any loss, injury or damage arising out of the storage, transit, transport, unloading, loading, erecting, dismantling and/or use of the Plant and all associated costs and charges.

(b) During the Period of Hire the Hirer shall insure the Plant at the Hirer's own expense against loss and damage from all risks (including third party risks) and indemnify the Owner against all loss or damage to the Plant not recoverable under the policy of insurance.

(c) The Hirer shall, in the event of loss of or damage to the Plant howsoever caused, be liable for the Hire Charges until the Hirer pays for the cost incurred by the Owner in respect of such loss and damage.

(d) If the Plant is involved in any accident resulting in injury to persons or damage to property, immediate notice must be given to the Owner by telephone and confirmed in writing to the Owner.

(e) The Hirer shall be responsible for the cost of the changing and repair of any tyre punctures and shall arrange for the tyre(s) to be repaired or replaced without awaiting the Owner's consent. The Hirer shall ensure that all replacement tyres meets the manufacturer's recommended specification and that all repairs are carried out to the highest standard of workmanship.

(f) If the ground (including any private access road or track) is soft or unsuitable for the Plant to work on, travel, or be transported over (including for delivery and collection) without suitable timbers or equivalents, the Hirer shall supply and lay suitable timbers or equivalents in a suitable position.

(g) The Hirer shall be responsible for the unobstructed access to, and (unless otherwise agreed in writing) loading, unloading, erecting and/or dismantling of the Plant at the Hirer's site. Any personnel supplied by the Owner for such work at the Hirer's site shall be deemed to be under the direction and control of the Hirer who shall be responsible for all claims arising out of the work

10. INDEMNITY TO OWNER

Where an operator is provided with the Plant, he shall work under the supervision and instructions of the Hirer or his representative who shall not permit any person other than the operator to operate the Plant without the Owner's prior written consent. During the Period of Hire the Hirer shall be responsible for the operator's actions as if he were in the Hirer's direct employ to the effect that the Hirer shall free and relieve the Owner of and from the consequences of all claims made against the Owner by (a) third parties as a consequence of any acts or omissions of the operator, including negligence or breach of statutory duty; and/or (b) the operator in respect of any loss injury or damage suffered by him except where that loss injury or damage arises as a consequence of any negligence of the Owner.

11. PROTECTION OF OWNER'S RIGHTS

(a) The Hirer shall not sell, sub-let, hire, assign, grant security over, deal with or part with possession or control of the Plant, or attempt to do so without the Owner's prior consent in writing.

(b) The Hirer shall not remove, deface or cover up the Owner's nameplate or mark on the Plant indicating that it is the Owner's property.

(c) Except as provided for by Condition 9(e), the Hirer shall not repair or adjust the Plant or attempt to do so unless authorised by the Owner in writing.

12. CHARGES

- (a) (1) Where the Plant is hired at a rate per Working Week the charge is based on a maximum of 39 hours per Working Week unless otherwise stated (Hours worked in excess of that maximum shall be charged pro-rata);
- (2) Where the Plant is hired on a basis of a rate per day the charge is based on a maximum of eight hours per day (except Friday which shall be seven hours) unless otherwise stated (Hours worked in excess of that maximum shall be charged pro-rata); and
- (3) Where the Plant is hired with an operator on the basis of a composite rate per Working Week or per day of a minimum or specified number of hours, any time for which it is working in excess of those hours shall be paid for pro-rata, the hourly rate being calculated by dividing the weekly rate or daily rate by the number of specified hours.
- (b) Overtime. When Plant is hired with an operator on the basis of separate Plant and operator rates, overtime shall be charged for hours worked in excess of the maximum or specified hours at the agreed Plant and operator rates plus the operator's premium overtime rates as applicable.
- (c) Standing Time. Where Standing Time is charged for it shall be at two thirds of the Plant rate plus the operator at his standard rate or at two thirds of any composite rate which has been charged for Plant and operator. In computing Standing Time, periods of shorter duration than those for which the rates are quoted shall be treated as working time. A standing period of less than a Working Week shall be treated as working time in the case of items of Plant being hired for a week of a specified number of hours and, in any event, a standing period of less than one day shall be treated as working time.
- (d) Assembling, Rigging and Dismantling. Time spent in assembling, rigging and dismantling Plant shall be charged to the Hirer.
- (e) Other Costs
- (i) Where the Plant is hired at a rate per Working Week the charge is based on a maximum of 39 hours per Working Week unless otherwise stated (Hours worked in excess of that maximum shall be charged pro-rata);
- (ii) Any consumable item, such as fuel, oil, AdBlue or grease supplied by the Owner shall be charged to the Hirer. It shall be the Hirer's responsibility, if purchasing such consumable items, to purchase items of good quality and which meet the appropriate specification for the Plant.
- (iii) Where appropriate, the cost of sharpening drills/steels etc shall be borne by the Hirer.
- (iv) The Hirer shall pay the costs of transport of the Plant from the Owner's depot or equivalent to the Hirer's site or other delivery location and also return to the Owner's depot or equivalent on expiry of the Period of Hire.

(v) The Hirer shall be responsible for the cost or expense of recovering any Plant from soft ground.

(vi) If using duty rebated fuel (like Red Diesel) the Hirer shall drain the tank of such fuel at the end of the Period of Hire and, if there is failure to do so, the cost of the Owner draining the tank and replenishing with duty paid fuel shall be charged to the Hirer at the minimum rate of one hours labour plus fuel used.

13. DETERMINATION OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR HIRE CHARGES

- (a) The Hire Charges shall run from the time of commencement of the Period of Hire until:-
- (i) Where the hire is for a fixed period, the expiry of that fixed period;
- (ii) Where the hire is not for a fixed period, or where the hire is continued after the expiry of the fixed period without any new period being determined, two days after either party shall have given to the other written notice to terminate the hire; or
- (iii) in any event, when the Hirer receives from the Owner a valid Off Hire Number in respect of the Plant; when the Hirer shall forthwith deliver the Plant to, or allow its uplift by, the Owner. Failure to do so will result in the Hirer being liable for the Hire Charges in respect of any period where there is delay in delivery or uplift which is not due to any act or omission of the Owner.

14. TERMINATION

- (a) If the Hirer:-
- (i) fails to pay any Hire Charges or other sums payable under the Contract when they become due (whether demanded or not);
- (ii) commits a breach of any other terms and conditions of the Contract; or
- (iii) shall do or allow to be done any act or thing which in the opinion of the Owner may jeopardise the Owner's rights in the Plant, then the Owner shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, have the right to automatically terminate the Contract without notice and without liability to the Hirer.
- (b) If any of the following events occur:-
- (i) the Hirer makes any voluntary arrangement with his creditors or (being an individual) shall die or (being an individual or firm) becomes bankrupt or (being a company) becomes subject to administration or goes into liquidation (otherwise than for the purpose of amalgamation or reconstruction) or an encumbrancer takes possession, or a receiver is appointed over any of the property or assets of the Hirer;
- (ii) the Hirer ceases or threatens to cease to carry on business;
- (iii) the Hirer is unable to pay his debts as they fall due; or

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF HIRE

(iv) Any diligence, execution or other legal process shall be levied on or against the Plant or against any premises where it is situated; then in each and every case the Contract shall automatically terminate without notice and without the Owner having any liability to the Hirer.

(c) The Hirer shall upon termination of the Contract under Conditions 14(a) or 14(b) pay to the Owner:-

(i) all arrears of Hire Charges then due under the Contract and all other sums accrued, due and unpaid by the Hirer to the Owner at the date of termination, together with interest payable under Condition 20 and any other sums due under any other agreement between the Owner and the Hirer; and

(ii) the cost of all repairs to the Plant required as at the date of termination (other than those for which the Owner has assumed responsibility under Condition 6).

(d) Termination of the Contract pursuant to Conditions 14(a) or 14(b) shall not affect any rights of the Owner or liabilities of the Hirer subsisting as at the date of termination.

(e) On termination of the Contract or expiry of the Period of Hire, the Hirer shall no longer be in possession of the Plant with the Owner's consent and shall (unless otherwise agreed with the Owner) forthwith return the Plant to the Owner at such address as the Owner may direct in good order and in good working condition and at the Hirer's expense and risk. Without prejudice to any other rights or remedies of the Owner under the Contract, the Owner may at any time after such termination, without notice, retake possession of the Plant for which purpose it shall be lawful for the Owner or his representatives to enter into or upon any premises or site where the Plant may be held, and the Hirer shall indemnify the Owner against all loss, damage, costs, or expenses so arising including in respect of third party claims.

15. OPERATED PLANT

The Hirer shall sign the operator's weekly time sheet, which shall be conclusive as to the working hours of the Plant, plus operator's driving and normal maintenance time. Operator's time spent on breakdown will be chargeable to the Hirer unless the repairs involved are necessary because of the fault of the Owner.

16. OUTRIGGERS AND STABILISERS

Any sound timber or other material supplied by the Owner for use with outriggers or stabilisers to the Plant is provided solely to assist the Hirer and expressly not to relieve him in any way from his legal, regulatory or contractual obligations to ensure adequate stability of Plant under imposed loading.

17. EXCLUSION OF WARRANTIES

All warranties, conditions or other terms implied by statute or common law with regard to the Plant, except as expressly provided in these Conditions, are expressly excluded to the fullest extent permitted by law.

18. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

(a) Except for liability for death or personal injury arising from the Owner's negligence or fraudulent misrepresentation, the Owner's obligation to repair or replace the Plant as provided in Condition 6 shall constitute the full extent of the Owner's liability in respect of any loss or damage sustained by the Hirer;

(b) The Owner shall not be liable to the Hirer for any indirect or consequential loss or damage (whether for loss of profit, loss of business, depletion of goodwill or otherwise) costs, expenses or other claims for consequential compensation whatsoever (howsoever caused) which arise out of or in connection with the Contract.

19. CONSUMER CREDIT LEGISLATION

Where the Contract is one to which the Consumer Credit Act 1974 as amended or re-enacted from time to time would otherwise apply it is an essential condition of the hire (unless the Owner and Hirer expressly agree in writing that the Contract shall subsist for a period of greater than 80 days) that it will terminate on the expiry of 80 days from its commencement and that there shall be no right or option on the part of the Hirer to require the Owner to extend the Contract or enter into a new contract of hire with the Owner. This clause is without prejudice to the provisions for termination contained in Condition 14.

20. INTEREST

All invoices are payable within 30 days of the invoice date. Time of payment shall be of the essence of these Conditions. In the event of late payment then, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, the Owner shall be entitled to charge interest at the rate of 3% per annum above the base rate of the Royal Bank of Scotland plc from time to time (both before and after any judgement) from the due date until settlement is received in full.

21. GOVERNMENT REGULATION

During the Period of Hire the Hirer shall be responsible for complying with statutory provisions or regulations in relation to the operation and use of the Plant.

22. DATA PROTECTION

Where the Hirer is a sole trader:-

(a) the Owner will take all reasonable precautions to keep the details of the Hirer's order and payment secure, but unless the Owner is negligent, the Owner shall not be liable for unauthorised access to information supplied by the Hirer; and

(b) the Owner will only use the information the Hirer provides about himself for the purpose of fulfilling the Owner's obligations under the Contract, unless the Hirer agrees otherwise. The Hirer may correct any information about himself or ask for information about himself to be deleted, by giving the Owner written notice in accordance with Condition 23(d).

23. MISCELLANEOUS

(a) The Owner shall use all reasonable endeavours to discharge its obligations under these Conditions in a prompt and efficient manner but does not accept responsibility for any failure or delay caused by circumstances beyond its control.

(b) No waiver by the Owner of any breach of these Conditions by the Hirer shall be considered as a waiver of any subsequent breach.

(c) If any provision of these Conditions is held by any competent authority to be invalid or unenforceable in whole or in part the validity of the other provisions of these Conditions and the remainder of the provision in question shall not be affected.

(d) Any notice required or permitted under these Conditions shall be in writing and shall be served by personal delivery, email (to the email addresses used by the Hirer and Owner when the order is placed) or by pre-paid first class post addressed to the other party at its registered office, principal place of business or such other address as has been notified pursuant to this provision to the party giving the notice. Any such notice shall be deemed to have been received if delivered personally, at the time of delivery, if served by email, at the time of transmission and in case of prepaid first class post, 48 hours from date of posting.

(e) The Owner may assign, transfer, charge or dispose of any of its rights, or sub-contract or otherwise delegate any of its obligations under the Contract.

(f) The Hirer may not assign, transfer, sub-contract or otherwise dispose of the benefit or burden of the Contract to a third party without the prior written consent of the Owner.

(g) A certificate signed for and on behalf of the Owner shall be sufficient to fix and ascertain the sums due by the Hirer to the Owner under the Contract and shall be conclusive of the amounts due.

(h) The Hirer consents to registration of the Contract and any certificate under Condition 23(g) for preservation and execution.

24. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

(a) The Scheme for Construction Contracts (Scotland) Regulations 1998 as amended or re-enacted from time to time (whether before or after the date of the Contract) ("the Regulations") shall apply to the Contract. The Contract may specify the person (if any) to act as adjudicator. For the purposes of the Regulations, the specified nominating body to select any adjudicator shall be the SPOA acting through its President from time to time.

(b) The Owner and Hirer shall comply forthwith with any decision of the adjudicator and where court action follows thereon, shall not defend such action and shall consent to decree and submit to enforcement in respect of any such decision, in each case without any defence, set-off, counter claim, abatement or deduction.

(c) Where the Owner, Hirer or adjudicator wishes to register a decision of the adjudicator for execution in the Books of Council and Session, any other party shall, on being requested to do so, forthwith consent to such registration by subscribing the decision before a witness.

25. GOVERNING LAW

These Conditions shall be governed and construed in accordance with the Law of Scotland and the Hirer hereby submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Scottish Courts.
